Circular

In continuation of our earlier Writ Petition no.39685/2016 wherein an interim order was issued, a fresh writ petition No.7376/2017 has been filed as directed by the Hon'ble Judge on 22/3/2017. This Writ Petition came up hearing on 27/3/2017 and fresh notices were ordered to be served to the respondents namely GIPSA, UIIC, NIC and OIC. Two weeks time has been given by the Hon'ble court to the respondents, which would essentially mean that the case would tentatively come up for hearing on 10/3/2017 or days after that. We are expecting a positive outcome this time around and it should happen very soon.

A jist of the Interim order is as follows:

“Though the Check-Off exercise is scheduled to take place on 16.11.2016, to safeguard the interest of all the parties, it is made clear that the result of the check-off exercise would be subject to the result of the writ petition”.

Meanwhile we wish to inform our comrades that representations have been sent to The Chairman, OBC Parliamentary Committee, New Delhi as well to the Ministry of Finance, New Delhi for an all inclusive Check-Off without any discrimination on the mode of appointment (Open Competition or Reservation Quota) as announced by GIPSA in its letter dated 11/11/2016, wherein it has announced **Check-Off only for those who are “Recruited as OBCs”**. In hot pursuit of our **goal for Check-Off to all OBCs**, we are leaving no stone unturned till the same is achieved.

At this point in time we would like to reveal with more authenticity as a corollary to what was stated in our circular dated 15.02.2017, that the Writ Petition No.40209/2016 by an OBC entity was filed on 15.11.2016 and was disposed of on 16.11.2016 (Check-Off for OBCs was announced by GIPSA on 11.11.2016).

We wish to once again reiterate that we will neither mislead nor misinform our fellow comrades and will only present true facts and take this movement further in the interest of our community as a whole. Lets be unified.
